Physical therapy is often beneficial to individuals with low back pain, joint pain, head or neck pain, or those who suffer from a stroke, Multiple Sclerosis, Arthritis, Osteoporosis or any lower extremity surgery, as well as many other diagnoses.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Occupational therapy is specialized treatment that helps individuals achieve independence in all areas of their lives. Treatment focuses on fine motor skills and activities of daily living. A wide variety of people (children and adults) can benefit from occupational therapy, including those with work related injuries, including upper extremity problems, or those who suffer from Arthritis, Multiple Sclerosis or other serious chronic conditions, as well as treatment to patients with a wide variety of diagnoses. OT staff also treats children with many different diagnoses, i.e. Autism, ADHD and developmental delay.

SPEECH LANGUAGE PATHOLOGY

Speech Therapists care for a wide range of patients from infants to the elderly. They treat patients with a number of possible diagnoses, such as stroke, Autism, hoarseness and speech delay, to name a few.
